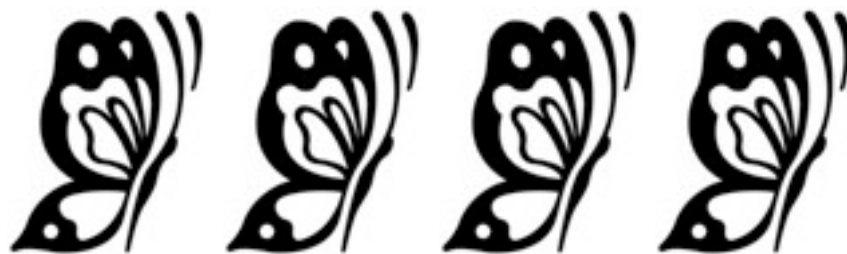
The meeting begins promptly at 7:30 p.m., so those of you who tend to run a little late might want to plan accordingly so that you are not late on this particular night.
