Batter Cobbler

½ Cup oleo or butter (1 cube)
1 Cup flour
1 Cup sugar
2 tsp baking powder
¾ Cup milk
4 Cups sweetened fruit with juice.

Melt butter or oleo in deep pan in which cobbler is to be baked (9 x 13)
Mix together flour, sugar, baking powder and milk. Pour batter over butter. Gently pour fruit over batter but do not stir. Bake 50 to 60 minutes in medium oven or until golden brown (350). Peaches, cherries, and berries are good.
