MUGS 4 HOSPITALIZED VETERANS

One of the projects that Lyn Sanchez does is to fill coffee mugs with items for hospitalized veterans. We can help her by collecting the following items that are put into each mug: Toothbrush, toothpaste, motel size soap, travel size shampoo and conditioner, and a comb. We will have a box at the Grange Hall for you to put these items in. Lyn puts the items in a mug, along with a small American flag and puts the mug and items in a cellophane sack and delivers them to the Veterans hospital in Albq.
