## Nurturing Pollinators Program



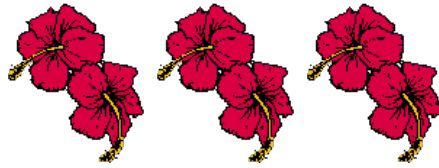
Friday March 12 Horvath
