- Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program (118)
- Taxes on Nicotine Products (EE)
- Citizenship Qualifications of voters (76)
- Local Voter Approval of Casino Bet Limits and Games in Black Hawk, Centrak City and Cripple
 Creek. (77)
- Repeal of Gallagher Amendment (B)
- Conduct of Charitable gaming (C).
